Golf Tournament – \$150

Big Ditch Brewery Flights & Bites – \$30

Thursday, June 1 | 2:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Join NYIA at the Big Ditch Brewery at 2:00 p.m. for an afternoon of flights, bites and networking. The Big Ditch is located in the heart of downtown and only a short walk from the conference hotel.

Pre-registration is required. Admission is \$30 and includes a tasting card for four samples of the Big Ditch’s signature and seasonal brews as well as food with local flare. A resident beer aficionado will provide attendees with a history of the brewery and a sneak peek into their craft. Don’t miss the chance to witness the spirit of the Erie Canal at the Big Ditch with fellow NYIA members and industry peers!

All of Big Ditch’s brews are produced on site. Big Ditch Brewing Company makes its beer using a 20-barrel (620-gallon) Criveller brewhouse. They expanded to a 15,000 square foot brewery on East Huron Street, that includes a Tap Room and Restaurant.

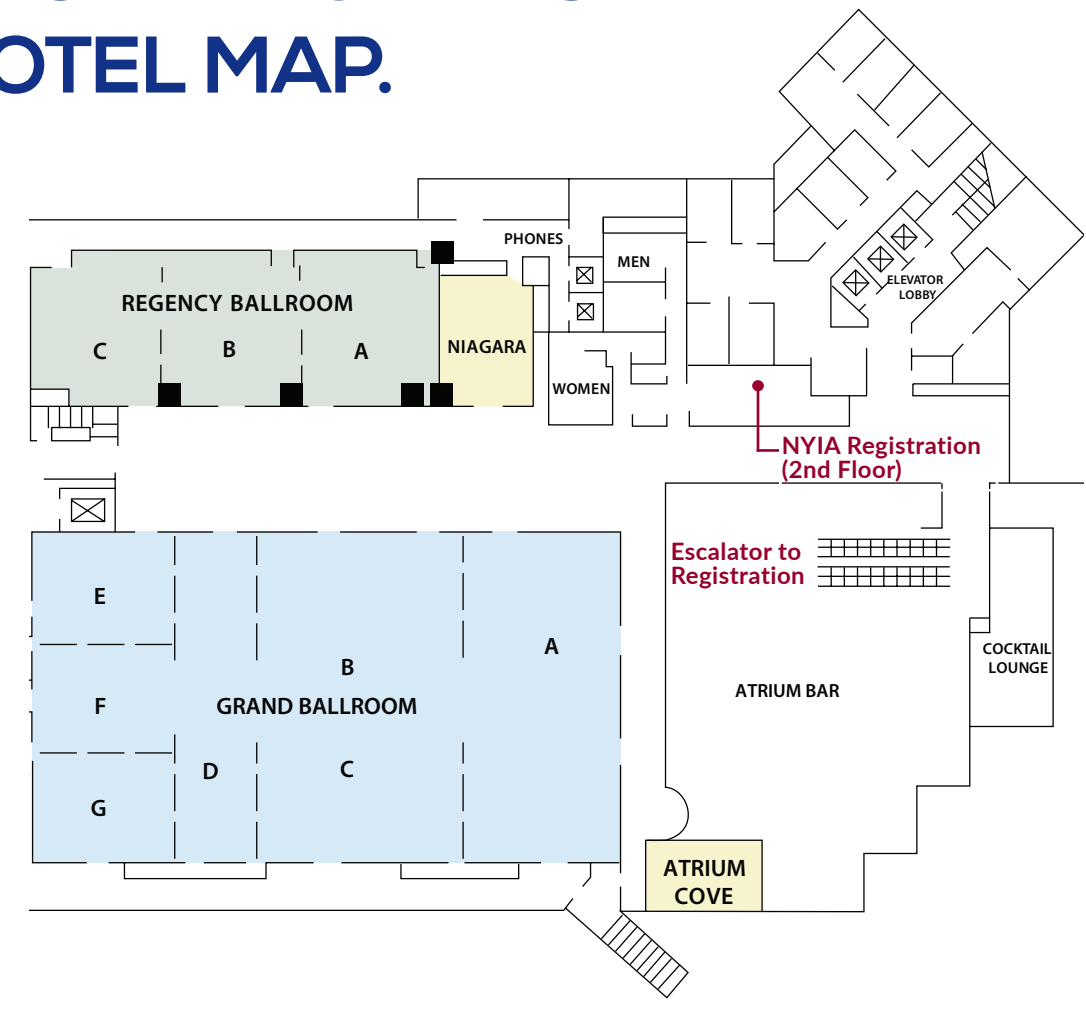
TRAVEL TIPS
